

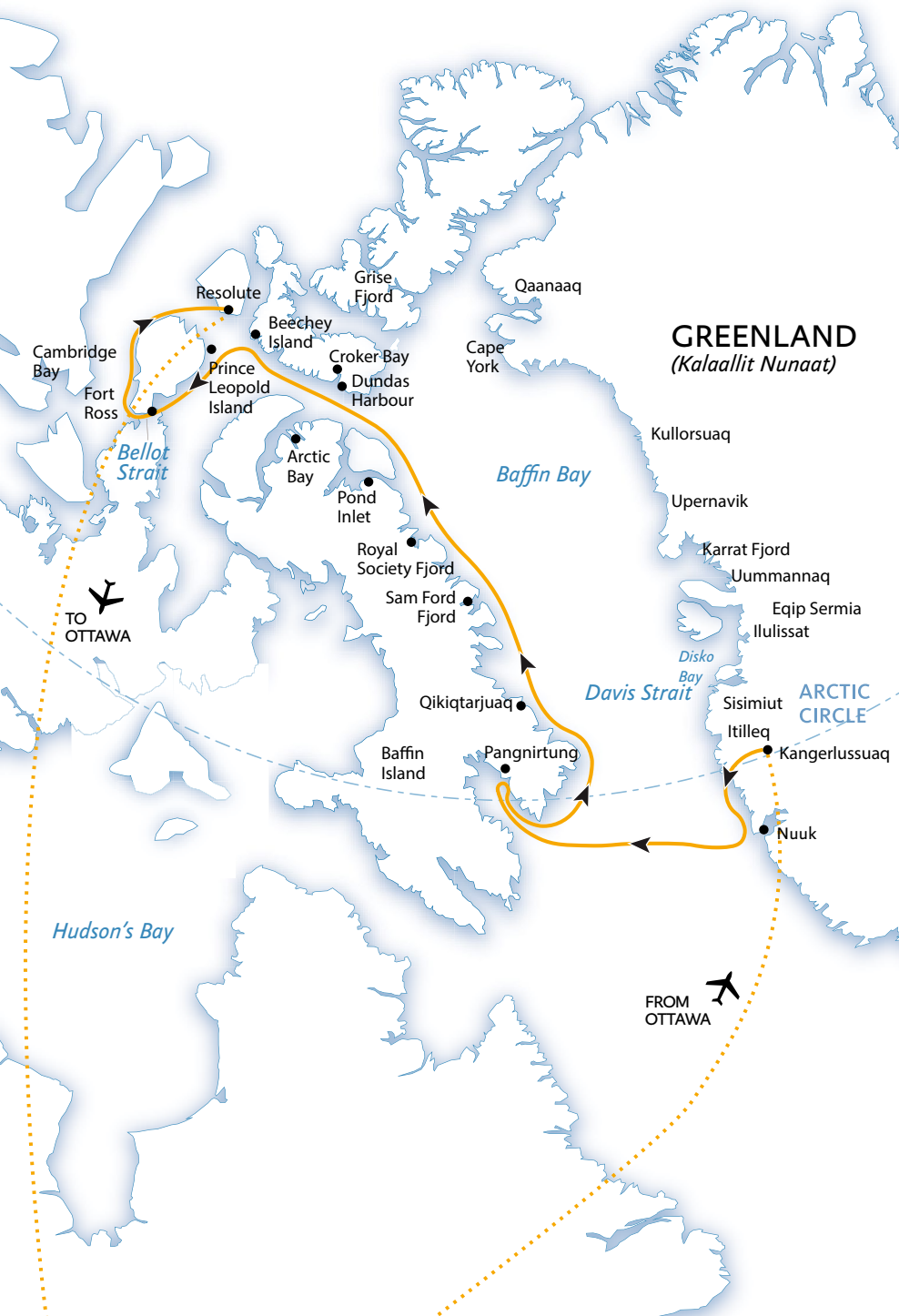
Canada to Greenland: Baffin Bay Explorer

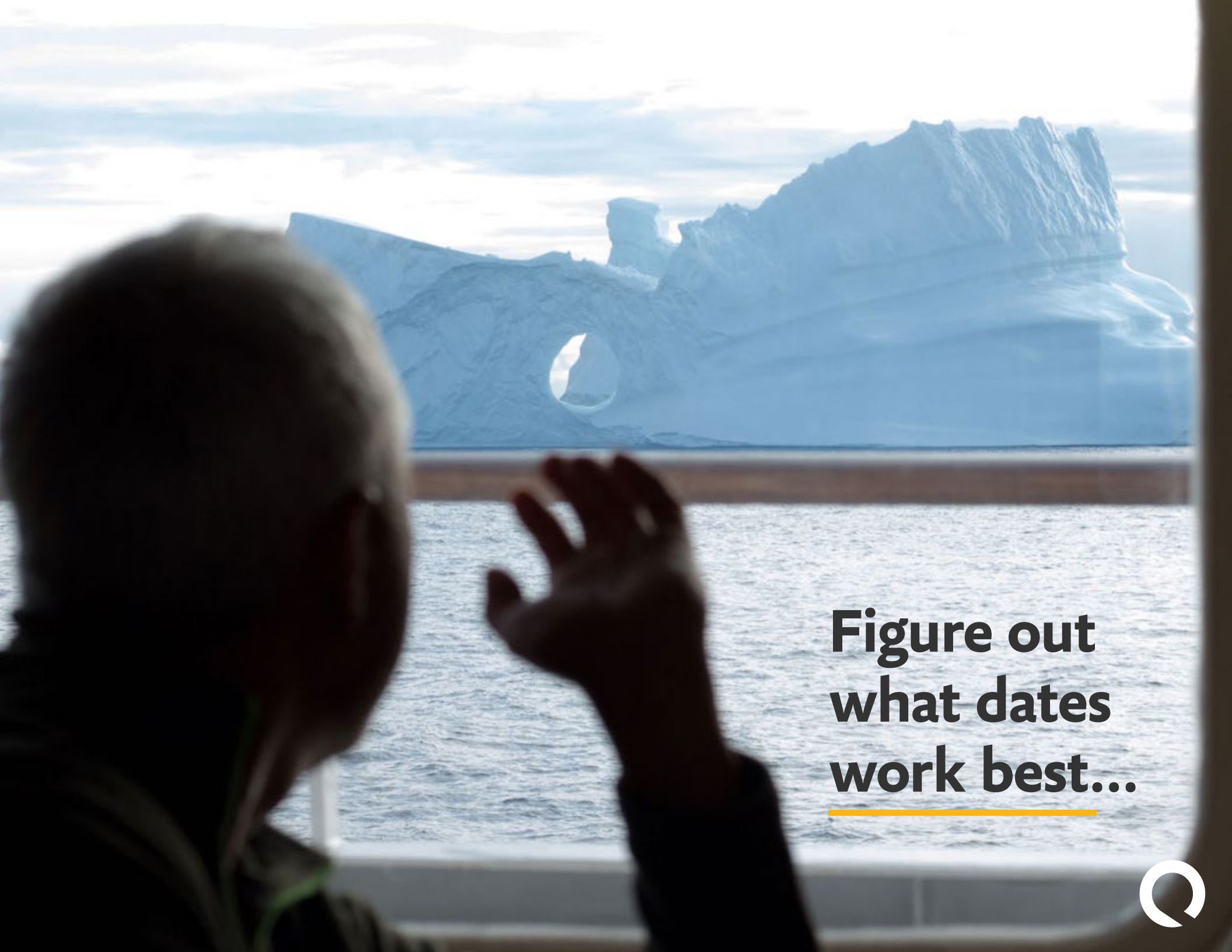
